# Scholarship Selection Criteria for M.Sc. Ag Students (Dalit & Indigenous Communities)

## 1. Academic Merit - 30 Marks

Evaluation based on Bachelor's level (B.Sc. Ag) academic performance (percentage/CGPA). Higher scores will receive higher preference.

## 2. Social Background - 20 Marks -

Must belong to a recognized Dalit or Indigenous community. Priority given to students from socially marginalized and underrepresented backgrounds.

## 3. Financial Status – 20 Marks

Preference to students from families with an annual income below NPR 300,000. Extra consideration for students from unemployed households, single-parent families, or those with disabilities.

#### 4. Leadership and Community Involvement – 15 Marks

Active involvement in student leadership, social work, or agricultural community service. Documented proof will be considered.

## 5. Recommendation & Motivation – 10 Marks \*

One academic recommendation letter from a professor/institution. A short Motivation Letter (Statement of Purpose) explaining the student's goals and need for the scholarship.

#### 6. Interview – 5 Marks

A brief online or in-person interview to assess the student's commitment, communication, and future vision.

Total: 100 Marks
